Let's learn about shapes by making Halloween decorations!

Halloween is a fun time to decorate the house with pumpkins. Use this opportunity to teach your child about shapes!

- Draw the shape of a pumpkin on orange paper. Cut out shapes like triangles, squares, and rectangles from black paper, and glue them on the pumpkin to make a jack-o-lantern. Talk about the shapes you used to make the eyes, nose, etc.
- Take a walk around your neighborhood and see if you can find Halloween decorations. Talk about what shapes you see.

**Open-ended question: What shapes did we use to make our jack-o-lantern?
What shapes do you see around us?**
