You and your child can work together to make one Valentine's Day card for every member of your family. Your child will practice counting by counting all the family members to determine how many card to make:

- With your child, make a list of all your family members. Have your child count how many names are on the list. Ask them, how many cards do we need to make? Discuss that you will make one card for each family member.
- Using materials such as paper, markers, glitter, and glue, have your child make a card for each family member (it doesn't matter what the cards look like; your child is just learning to draw).
- Go over the list of names with your child to make sure that there is one card for
