



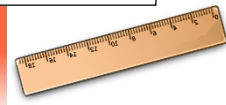
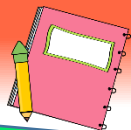

Help your child learn language!

- Everyone needs language to communicate our wants, needs, and ideas.
- **Children start learning language on the day they are born. Babies start with crying, babbling, and cooing, and then move to first words and first sentences.**
- Boost your child's language by talking to him or her throughout the day when you are cooking, bathing, and doing chores. Comment on what you're doing and what you see. As a bonus, your child will be less likely to get bored or misbehave!
- **Singing songs and doing finger plays is also a great way to build your child's oral language and vocabulary.** Have fun singing with your child!

Start a conversation with your child as you give them a bath. Ask, what toys do you like to play with in the bathtub and why?
