Your child can work on developing literacy skills by helping you prepare for Thanksgiving dinner! Here are some ways:

- Have your child make name cards for everyone who will be sitting at the Thanksgiving table. They can draw pictures and you can add the names or, if they are ready, they can sound out names and add letters.
- Have your child draw a picture of something they are thankful for. You can write words on the picture or help your child sound out words and write letters.
- Look for words in magazines related to Thanksgiving, such as "turkey" and "stuffing." Show your child these words and talk about their letters.
