Let's Count The Days of the Month!

December is a fun time to look at and talk about calendars as many children like to track the days until Christmas. You can use your calendar for a math activity about counting:

- Every day with your child, look at the number on the calendar that corresponds to that day. Discuss the number, and have your child find that number of things around the house. For instance, on December 5th, your child can find 5 forks or 5 pencils.
- Continue the game each day for the rest of the month. When you get into the higher numbers, your child might need your help finding and counting larger numbers of things.
