### Make A Family Book With Your Child!

December is often a time of getting together with family and friends. Use these opportunities to teach your child about the written word by making a family book.

- Make a family book together. You can discuss how big the book should be, what shape, and how many pages it should have. Fold paper in half and staple along the fold to make a book.
- Use photographs of family members or have your child draw family members.
- Let your child tell you what to write on each page of the book. Your child can decorate the front and inside pages of the book. Don't worry if your child scribbles on the pages – it is about the process of having fun together, not the finished product!
- Help your child decorate the family book. You can use glitter, paint, stickers or anything else you have available!
- Have your child "read" the book to friends and family at get-togethers.
